The short answer to your question is that Kirtland will implement this law as directed by the Department of Defense. Currently, we are operating as normal - accepting all state issued identification - pending further guidance and direction from the DoD.

REAL ID Act Information Sheet

The Real ID Act was passed by the United States Congress in 2005 and enacted the 9/11 Commission's recommendation that the federal government set standards for the issuance of sources of identification, such as driver's licenses.

Real ID is not a US Air Force policy, but a federal law. Kirtland is implementing this law as directed and with guidance from the Department of Defense. Currently, Kirtland is operating as normal, and is accepting all state issued identification, pending further guidance from the DoD. The Department of Homeland Security may approve waivers at any time, for any state. When the Real ID standards are fully implemented in New Mexico, the forms of identification acceptable are below.

Forms of acceptable identification under the REAL ID Act are:

| -US passport card | -INS Form 766 |
| -Transportation Worker's Identification Card | -Permanent Resident Card |
